AJR SPONSORS SCREENING OF *STEALING KLIMT* PREMIER

The Association of Jewish Refugees (AJR) is delighted to be sponsoring the premier screening of *Stealing Klimt*, the story of Maria Altmann's battle to recover her family's artworks stolen by the Nazis following the occupation of Austria.

Organised by the Jewish film Festival, the screening will take place on Wednesday 27 February at the Odeon Swiss Cottage. The film will be followed by a panel discussion featuring the AJR's Dr Anthony Grenville, a historian on Jewish refugees from Nazi Europe, the film's writer and executive producer Martin Smith, historian Professor David Cesarani and Minister of the Austrian Embassy, Ms Elisabeth Koegler (participating in her personal, non-official capacity).
